After a career as a chemist, she chose the path of art and is a signature member of the American Watercolor Society, National Watercolor Society, Society of Layerists in Multi-media and several state water media organizations. She has been a juror of most national exhibitions, sought after workshop teacher, and author of the book, “Watermedia Techniques for Releasing the Creative Spirit.”

She has been elected to two Halls of Fame and given the Lifetime Achievement Award by the West Virginia Watercolor Society.
