

India Ink and Watercolor Drawing 1-Day Workshop

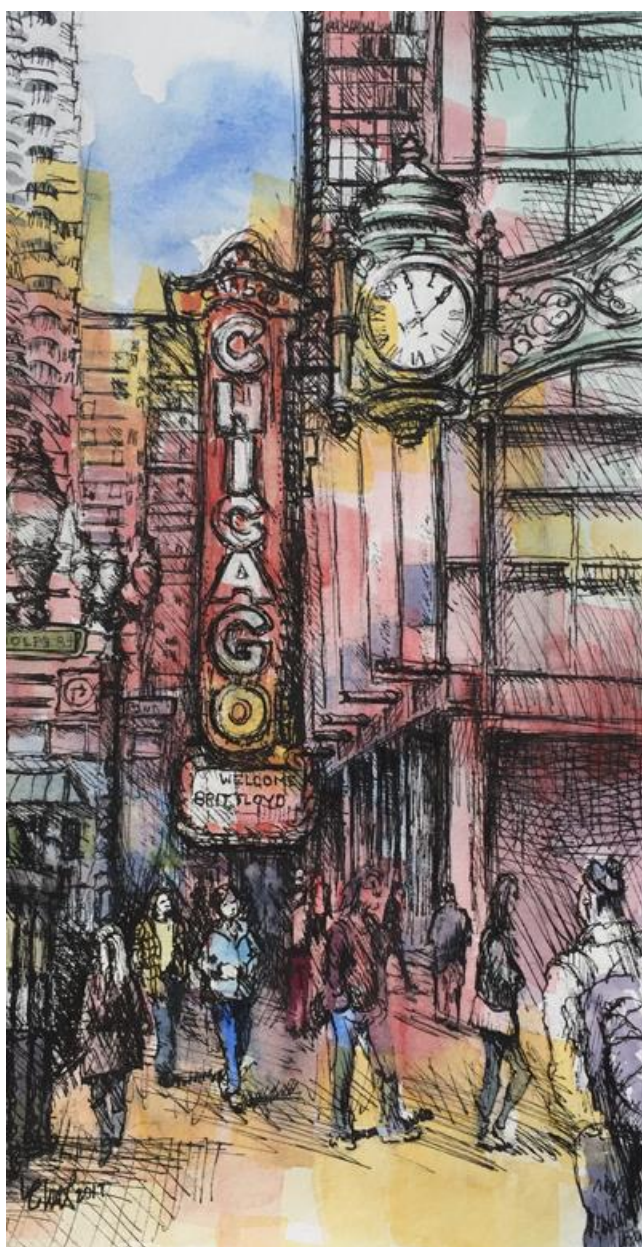

Course Materials

Participants will be addressing the use of adding watercolors to ink drawings in a one-day workshop. After a presentation of imagery and materials, students will receive instruction on the basics of linear perspective, if needed, as well as hatching, cross hatching and stippling. The rest of the workshop time will be spent in creating ink and watercolor drawings.

Participants need to bring the following materials:

- Favorite original images as resources electronically or printed, any genre.
- A sketchbook/journal that has all purpose white paper with 80# paper or higher.
OR bring a sketchbook/journal with smooth watercolor paper.
- Favorite drawing pencils and eraser
- Favorite flat and round brushes 1” or smaller
- Faber-Castell (black) artist pen: S or F point (the letter will show on the cap).
These are not marker pens and are filled with permanent ink. They can be found at any art store like Michaels, AC Moore, or Hobby Lobby.
- Your favorite watercolors, palette, water containers, and towels.

About the instructor:

Linda Elmer is a retired art teacher from Marion County Schools where she taught art for 34 years. Linda graduated from Fairmont State University in 1981 and West Virginia University in 1991. One of her favorite genres is cities, and she enjoys drawing these scenes by combining ink and watercolors. You can find her work at Artistry on Main in Buckhannon, WV.
