The following must be adhered to in order to participate in the WVWS All Member Exhibit 2024: “Anything Goes”:

- Water-based media on any surface. There is no age limit on the pieces but they must have not been shown in any previous WVWS exhibits. This is a members’ only exhibit. Work is not juried therefore, all paintings will be hung, if framing and content is deemed acceptable. Members may submit 3 paintings. With “Anything Goes”, we hope to see some new and creative techniques.
- All work must be framed properly (no poster frames) and under plexi-glass—no regular or glazed glass...(when glass applies). Regular glass can be used on 16x20 and smaller. Wire hangers only. No saw-tooth hangers. The gallery reserves the right to not hang a painting if rules are not followed or if content is deemed unacceptable or inappropriate.
- **Shipped work is to be mailed in time for it to be received by September 25 to: Linda Elmer, 46 Dogwood Lane, Fairmont, WV 26554. Phone number: 304- 216-8498 or 304-366-9793.** Paid, return shipping labels must be provided or work will not be returned. **Contact person at gallery is Harmony Flora: education@carnegiehallwv.org.**
- All work must be original. No stock photos or internet images are allowed (not an original source). Purchased stock photos as a source are not permitted. No work may be submitted that was done during a workshop or heavily influenced by another artist. There is no time limit (as to when they have been created) on these pieces. No work should have been shown in a previous WVWS exhibit.
- Sales—The gallery retains 30%. The WVWS will retain 5% so price your work accordingly.
- Drop off/Pick up---Work can be delivered week of September 23 from 10-2. Linda Elmer and Deborah Lester can be contacted for delivery by dropping off to them in Fairmont and Beckley. Work must be picked up January 1-7 from 10- Noon. or by arrangement through education@carnegiehallwv.org.**more on page 2.....**

- Awards—Entry fees--along with a limited amount from the treasury--will determine the size of the awards. Hopefully, a minimum of \$1,600 in award money will be given. The exhibit will be judged for awards, but not juried for entry. All properly framed paintings will be hung.
- Art Bin—Artists in the exhibit can submit up to 3 unframed pieces or cards for the art bin. These are additional sale items for the artist. (see additional page for those qualifications). These must be sent in with your pre-registration page. You need to pre-register so an inventory list can be created.
